Gladstone International Singles League Rules

- 1 All matches to be played at Gladstone Club and to the International ruleset.
- 2 All matches consist of 10 frames and each frame won will count towards the aggregate.
- 3 points will be awarded for a win and 1 point will be awarded for a draw. If players are tied on points at the end of the season, then league position will be first based on wins, followed by frames won, if places till remain level then the head to head between both players will be taken into account.
- 4 The home player will have choice of which table to play on.
- 5 Players must lag for break, then alternative breaks thereafter.
- 6 Players must arrange their own games with their opponent. If the 2 players can't set a date, then the Committee will set a date.
- 7 Due to the number of matches a booking system for tables will be in place, this should avoid players turning up for a match to find that all the tables are already in use. To book a table you should contact Nick Hubert on 07540 389777 to confirm the table is free and to book it. Please bear in mind that there may be games on before that may overrun, if so you will need to wait for that game to finish. Please also remember to cancel a booking if for any reason you need to reschedule, this will allow other players the chance to reserve it.
- 8 Players cannot play more than 2 matches ahead of schedule, unless agreed to do so with the Committee.
- 9 No matches to be played on a Wednesday night during the N&DPL season.
- 10 Scoresheets will be available from behind the bar.
- 11 The singles league is now divisional so handicaps no longer apply.
- 12 In the event of a player resigning from the league during the first half of the season, all their previous results will be deemed void.
- 13 In the event of a player resigning from the league during the second half of the season, all first half results will stand and any second half results played will be deemed void.
- 14 The £1 per match is now scrapped but added into the entry fee
- 15 The Top 4 of each division will win prize money. The remaining 6 in each division will go into a knockout which will be best of 9 frames.

5th & 6th Place - Automatic entry into the Semi Final 7th v 10th - Play off for Semi Final place 8th v 9th - Play off for Semi Final place

- 16 24 of the 40 players will win some money.
